HOW TO CONNECT

1. Put the speaker in pairing mode first. Turn on the speaker and long-press the device's Bluetooth button.
2. Turn on Bluetooth on your smartphone. Select the Bluetooth settings to option in your phone's settings (both Android and iOS).
3. Hold your breath and wait for the phone to connect.

HOW TO PAIR

1ST STEP: Activate the pairing mode on the speaker.

Turn on the speaker and hold down the Bluetooth button on the device for several seconds. Your Bluetooth speaker will enter pairing mode and become discoverable to other devices when you push the button.

HOW TO FIX PAIRING PROBLEMS

If your Bluetooth devices won't pair, it's probably because they're out of range or not in pairing mode. Frequently Asked Questions

- **Why is the light on my Bluetooth speaker blinking?**

Unpaired Bluetooth headsets are the most prevalent cause of flashing red and blue lights. The headphones are looking for a way to connect with one other. It's conceivable that you pressed the pairing button by accident. The status lights glow red and blue, indicating that the headphones are in pairing mode.

- **What is the best way to tell if your speaker is completely charged?**

If the battery is fully charged, the CHARGE indicator will not light up. The CHARGE indicator may not light up while charging the speaker with the power turned on, depending on the model. The CHARGE indicator will light up if the battery is being charged when the speaker is switched off.

- **What does a Bluetooth speaker's blue light mean?**

Your speaker is in discoverable mode if it has a blinking blue light.

- **Why isn't my Bluetooth pairing working?**

To reset Wi-Fi, mobile, and Bluetooth on an Android phone, navigate to Settings > System > Advanced > Reset Options > Reset Wi-Fi, mobile, and Bluetooth. To unpair all of your devices on iOS and iPadOS, go to Settings > Bluetooth, tap the info icon, then select Forget This Device for each device, then restart your phone or tablet.

- **What's the deal with my Bluetooth speaker not working?**

Make sure your speaker is fully charged. Even if you connect the USB charging cord, the speaker will not turn on if the battery is dead. Before using the speaker, let it charge for about an hour.

- **What is the procedure for resetting my Chinese Bluetooth speaker?**

Restore factory defaults Long press the "M" key for 3 seconds in Bluetooth connection mode, and the blue light

will blink rapidly, returning the speaker to factory settings.

- **Is it necessary to have Internet access in order to utilize a Bluetooth speaker?**

- Bluetooth relies on short-range radio waves rather than an internet connection to function. This means that Bluetooth will operate whenever two compatible devices are present – no data plan or even a cellular connection is required.

- **Why isn't my iPhone recognizing my speaker?**

Make sure Bluetooth is enabled, and then try connecting your device using the Bluetooth settings. If your iPhone still won't connect to Bluetooth, try removing other Bluetooth devices from the settings, upgrading your iOS software, resetting your network settings, or restarting your iPhone.

- **What's the deal with my speaker glowing red?**

The portable speaker is in protect mode if the POWER indication is glowing red. This can happen if you plug in a device that isn't compatible with the speaker or if it gets too hot.

- **What is the procedure for turning off the blinking light on my Bluetooth earbuds?**

Put the headphones in pairing mode (flashing red and blue) and then push the volume down button to turn off the flashing LED indicator light. After that, turn the headphones off, then on, and connect them to your device in the usual way.
